IMPORTANT INITIAL STEPS

As soon as possible and within the first 5 days you must do the following:

- Notify the deceased's GP
- Register the death within the sub district of where the deceased passed away and obtain official copies of the death certificate. You will need sufficient copies to send to various authorities
- Find their Will if they left one
- Start making funeral arrangements with the Funeral Director

What to do when somebody passes away



'TELL US ONCE'

The 'Tell Us Once' is a service that lets you report a death to most government organisations in one go. When you register the death, the registrar will let you know if the service is available in your area.

Before you use this service, you will need the following details of the deceased.

- Date of birth
- National Insurance number
- Driving licence number (if applicable)
- Vehicle registration number (if applicable)
- Passport number (if applicable)

You'll also need:

- Details of any benefits or entitlements they were receiving, for example, State Pension
- Details of any local council services they were getting, for example, Blue Badge
- The name and address of their next of kin
- The name and address of any surviving spouse or civil partner
- The name, address and contact details of the person or company dealing with their estate (property, belongings and money)
- Details of any public sector or armed forces pension schemes they were getting or paying in to

USING A LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

If a Will was made, the executor(s) can instruct a Legal Professional, such as an Estate Planning Specialist to apply for probate and if needed to administer the estate. Without a Will an appointed representative, (often a relative) can also appoint a Legal Professional and in both cases the legal costs can be paid for by the estate.

These legal costs are a legitimate expense and any executor or administrator are able to do this. As property values increase, it is important to claim all of the available allowances so that Inheritance Tax is minimised. The addition of the Residence Nil Rate band in April 2017 has added another level of complexity to administering an estate. Legal specialists are used to dealing with deceased estates and have relevant knowledge of the law and the tax implications.

WHAT INFORMATION WILL THE LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE NEED?

You will need to take them:

- Death certificate and copies
- Financial information including, savings, assets, investments and debts
- Any recent household bills
- Title deeds to property or mortgage information
- Will or, if no Will, a family tree
- Birth certificate
- Marriage certificate
- National insurance number
